ARTIST SPOTLIGHT

Ron Black grew up in a household in which craftsmanship was accepted as a daily occurrence; it was in all you did. His grandmother put a wooden crochet hook, (whittled by his grandfather), in his hand when he was 9 years old. Ron never put that hook down, and still has it! Even though he never knew them, his mother's grandparents both made music on the banjo, guitar, fiddle, piano, and organ. They all played "by ear"; the same way Ron does. His wife and he are both weavers, having learned at Fireside Industries, Berea College, Berea, KY. They met there and were married in the college chapel. Ron wove the material for his wife's wedding dress at Fireside. Ron is retired from the office of the Attorney General, State of Ohio. Ron's artwork will be on display at Gallery on High, July 14 - Aug. 12. He will also talk on his work and music at our August LVAG meeting.
