

## GOBA - COBRA - STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL ARE COMING TO LONDON!

We will have a 4 day opportunity to promote the Gallery on High and art sales from June 22nd through June 25th. The Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure will arrive mid-day on June 22nd with approximately 3000 people arriving in cars and on bicycles. They will be looking for something interesting to do and the gallery and studio will attract a lot of attention. We should be open from roughly 1 PM to 8 PM. Small items sell well, such as cards and small works of art. Larger works will have to be shipped, such as the redware. The GOBA folks will also be in town on the 23rd when the Strawberry Festival begins. The prime time for adults for the Strawberry Festival will be from 4 to 8 on Thursday and Friday and from 10 to 6 Saturday. This event brings a lot of people to London. Our biggest need will be volunteers to keep the gallery and studio open for those 4 days. We will need at least 3 or 4 people there whenever we are open.
