The 2012 Visions of Hope calendar is now available at the First United Methodist Church of London, as well as locations mentioned below. This calendar showcases some wonderful artists in our county who donated the use of their art work in this calendar, which sells for \$10. Thanks to the generous sponsorship of Edward and Michelle Goodyear, the entire amount raised from sales will be used to support Lift Up On High for the coming year. #### "The BEST of Madison County" 2012 Calendar Has Arrived!

Thirty six artists entered the Visions of Hope first annual calendar contest. The community voted and the top twelve have been selected. One hundred percent of the proceeds will benefit the Visions of Hope "Lift Up On High" program. "LIFT UP ON HIGH" is a program designed to give a "LIFT UP" to single mothers and their children. "LIFT UP ON HIGH" is an apartment building consisting of four apartments with one apartment being for a caregiver that will be a 24/7 on-site problem solver. The other three furnished apartments will be for our single mother families in need of a "lift up."

VOH works closely with county family advocates to place families that were otherwise homeless in the "LIFT UP" program to help them once again become independent. Once in, VOH will provide a furnished apartment, resources for baby sitting, resources for continuing education, and a community that enables these families to support one another.


